

SPECIAL TROOPS, BERLIN BRIGADE

Special Troops, Berlin Brigade was organized in July 1945 as the 7780 Composite Service Battalion. The unit name was changed to Headquarters and Service Battalion, 7781st Army Unit, and later to Special Troops, United States Army Garrison. On 1 December 1961 it was changed to the present designation:

Special Troops, Berlin Brigade.

The Special Troops mission is to provide personnel, administrative and logistical support to Berlin Brigade.
